Hi my name is Mario Brown and I would like to congratulate you on obtaining this ebook.

I have to explain some of the important terminology first so that everybody is on the same level, newbies and advanced marketers.

## Page Rank (PR)

In short and simple words PageRank is a “vote”, by all the other pages on the Web, about how important a page is. A link to a page counts as a vote of support. If there’s no link there’s no support.

The Page Rank of a page depends upon the number of votes (backlinks)

it gets and the quality of these votes. , the importance of the page that is casting the vote determines how important the vote itself is. So if your website receives links from high PR sites then your site would most likely also get a good PR over time.

So it's important to realize that PageRank is Google's way of deciding a page's importance. And the more important your site is in google's eyes, the better your chances are to rank high.

### Link Juice

Link Juice is the weight or quality that one website can give to other websites via links (votes). In order to achieve a high Page Rank, we have to accumulate as much link juice as possible. Note that you won't receive link juice for every backlink you get. We need "Dofollow" links in order to get the necessary link juice for a good Page Rank.

### Backlinks and Nofollow/Dofollow

According to Wikipedia: basic link terminology, a backlink is any link received by a web page from another web page. Backlinks are also known as incoming links or inbound links

According to Google, a backlink from Page A to Page B is counted as a favorable editorial vote from Page A for Page B.

So in short, Backlinks are the incoming links to a web page or Website.

### Nofollow

According to Google: From now on, when Google sees the attribute (rel="nofollow") on hyperlinks, those links won't get any credit when we rank websites in our search results. This isn't a negative vote for the

site where the comment was posted.

So in short, nofollow links don't pass any link credit along in google's eyes. So we need dofollow links in order to receive link juice and therefore Page Rank.

A nofollow link has the following syntax:

```
<a href="http://www.LINKING-SITE-URL" rel="nofollow">Link Text</a>
```

## Dofollow

Dofollow links do pass link juice and therefore help you gaining Page Rank.

That's why everybody's after dofollow links.

A dofollow link has the following syntax:

```
<a href="http://www.LINKING-SITE-URL">Link Text</a>
```

## Related (targeted) Backlink

A Targeted Backlink is a link from a webpage that is related to the page it is linking to. Let's assume that your site is about Rigatoni, then a link from a site related to Pasta is considered a Targeted backlink.

The anchor text, or the backlink text, must include keywords which are targeted to the content the anchor text links to. It is recommended to use keyword targeted backlink text in writing your site's articles and when submitting your web page to directories.

## Conclusion

Ok I want you to understand that all the above stuff is related to Google. Fortunately there are more Search Engines which can bring significant traffic and they use different algorithms.

Yes, you should focus on getting targeted dofollow backlinks, but don't pass on nofollow links. Google may ignore no-follow backlinks but these are still useful for other search engines such as Yahoo!, MSN, etc.

Any backlink is better than no backlink!

Understand that Search engines value the quantity, quality, and relevance of backlinks.

### [Ninja Secrets Revealed](#)

#### **Important note:**

I'll provide you a massive list of good blogs and forums which you can use to link to your site. I encourage you to leave good, relevant and valuable comments, articles and posts.

Nobody likes spam. Furthermore there is a good chance that your links will stay alive if you post something meaningful. High PR blogs/forums are well moderated and they will delete comments that look spammy.

So take 2 minutes before commenting to scan through the other posts and then make good relevant posts yourself.

Many backlink books are huge because they integrate long directory lists – I think that sucks.

To make this neat, I've provided you with txt. Files where I provide you massive lists with all the relevant directories. I will point to them when

necessary.

Ok now that I got that off my shoulder, we can move on to the fun part. Beside the supercool ninja techniques, I'll also provide you a massive list of blogs/forums etc. that you can use to link to your site. The procedure is almost always the same. Register with the site, edit your profile and leave your anchor text link (if possible) in the 'Your Website' field or make a comment linking to your site.

This is exactly how your anchor text link should look like:

`<a href="http://www.yourdomain.com">your keywords</a>`

Now follow me along as I'm going to show you hundreds of ways to get backlinks and traffic. Be on the lookout for the German Ninja Techniques.

Commit only one hour a day to these strategies and you'll get awesome results.

## Link Exchange Clubs

You can gain backlinks exchanging links with your own website. You can use

DigitalPoint and Sitepoint for link exchanges. Try to exchange links related to your niche though. If you want to really boost your link exchange success rate you gotta pretend to be a woman. It will be way easier to gain quality links if you pretend to be a woman contacting/asking other webmasters.

You will find a list of link exchange clubs in your ninja source.

You may create an account → My Bookmarks ->Edit it

You'll receive a posting box where you can leave your anchor text link

Register → Choose any (or related) story you like → Use the 'comment' option to create your HTML anchor text at the bottom of the page

<http://www.blurtit.com/> (PR5)

Again like yahoo answers, just answer a question and set a dofollow anchor backlink to your site.

<http://www.gather.com/> (PR 6)

Gather.com has more than 500,000 sites indexed in Google, works a little like Squidoo. These sites allow you to submit articles which can backlink to your site. You can submit lots of articles and therefore receive backlinks and search engine traffic.

### [German Ninja Technique 1](#)

The Creativity Booster aka Get hundreds of unique articles in 5 minutes flat

Okay this is a easy but powerful trick to get your creativity on.

Most of you are into article marketing as a form of getting back links and I'm sure you know the feeling when you sit in front of a blank page and you have no ideas.

Ok let me bring you the solution and follow along.

We are going to use foreign articles to get our creativity on tour and we can even get unique (passing copyscape) articles this way.

Head over to: <http://babelfish.yahoo.com/> (The best free translation tool in my opinion)

Now go to <http://www.google.com/> and click the small link called: 'preferences' (on the right side of the Google search window)

Now select any language

For examples sake I'll choose Dutch. -> Save preferences

Now enter something like 'Blog' into the Google search box.  
(Be creative here, you can use any online dictionary to translate words like 'articles', 'article directory', 'post' or 'your niche' from a foreign language into English. Then just go ahead and enter the translated word into the foreign Google search box.

I found a site called: <http://blog.nl/> (there are so many more)

Now here comes the fun part -> Copy the URL (<http://blog.nl/>) and go to Bablefish.

Now enter the URL into the field where it says in bold: Translate a webpage

Below that field, choose translation Dutch to English.

That's it :)

Please realize that Bablefish will translate THE WHOLE PAGE into English.

That means just right there you got like hundreds if not thousands of UNIQUE articles !!

(you have to proofread them tough)

And that's just one site, using one language :)

I hope you see how powerful this is. I'm using this method myself and it's absolutely fantastic to get ideas and content. (which passes copy scape)

Now it's up to you to use your creativity. What can you do with this?

I'll give you 2 hints.

- This report is obviously about back links, so proofread these articles and submit them to article directories in order to get massive back links
- Use it as fresh content for your blog

There are other ways to use this method, get your creativity going.

### Ebay Blog Sensation

Most people still don't know that you can create your own blog on your Ebay site. I'm still an Ebay Powerseller (but not for long anymore as I'm not a fan of the recent changes) and the best thing is that Ebay has a Pagerank 5 and you can use your blog posts to link to your page. Guess what, the links that you will post are do-follow, using your anchor text. :)

Obviously, you'll need an Ebay account. To get started, visit <http://blogs.ebay.com/> and start your own Ebay blog.

Pick an article you like → Comments → You gotta use HTML inside your comment in order to create your anchor text.

<http://abovethelaw.com/> (PR7)

Register - > Edit Profile → Use the 'Bio' box to create your anchor text backlink

<http://yedda.com/> (PR7)

Works like yahoo answers. Look for questions related to your niches/keywords and answer them linking to your site. You'll receive backlinks and traffic.

### Buying Solid High PR Links

Now this is quite obvious, still lots of people aren't doing it. You can go to the Warrior forum

<http://www.warriorforum.com/warrior-reciprocal-links-buy-sell-swap/>

or Digital Point forum

(<http://forums.digitalpoint.com/forumdisplay.php?f=58>) and easily buy

solid backlinks. You can even choose links related to your niche. This is one of the easiest ways to get Page Rank 5-8 links related to your niche.

Do it!

Register → Choose an article of your interest → Click 'comments' and use HTML to leave your anchor text link at the bottom of your comment

Register → Click 'Your Account' → Profile → Create your anchor text backlink using HTML in the 'describe yourself' field

### Multi User (MU) Backlink Power

WordPress Multi-User is a fork of WordPress created to allow simultaneous blogs to exist within one installation. WordPress MU

makes it possible for anyone with a website to host their own blogging community, control, and moderate all the blogs from a single dashboard.

So basically you can let visitors create their own blogs on your domain, creating multi-user blog communities.

Google loves these blog communities and their links carry a lot more weight than links created by any other common linking strategy, e.g. social networking sites or normal blogs. So far they don't get a lot of attention, but that will change soon. For now, let's take advantage of their link power before everybody jumps on the bandwagon.

It's quite simple to do that. We just gotta find related MU blogs, create an account and post an article with anchor text linking to our site. And then just repeat it. Again, these links have significantly more weight than the ones you get from Digg or other social sites.

Here is how we find these powerful blog communities.

Let's go to google and enter `"/wp-signup.php"`. As of writing this, there are 17,200 results. Heaps of MU blogs ready for you to post articles containing your links. By entering `"/wp-signup.php"` you'll get forwarded directly to the easy signup form after clicking .

Now you just sign up and begin posting articles with anchor text pointing to your site. That's it.

Rinse and repeat.

You can use my first ninja trick to create lots of unique articles for free which you can post on the MU blogs. Also go ahead and submit those to different directories in order to get even more back links.

## [German Ninja Technique 2](#)

Backdoor Backlink Getter aka how to find high page rank links in 1 Minute flat

I will show you a killer easy and quick way that will help you to find high page rank blogs/sites/forums that are related to your niche. You will be able to find them quickly, leave posts linking to your site giving you a very strong dofollow that is related to your niche. (very important)

Let's say we own a blog related to the Internet marketing niche.

In order to make this work, we will have to find any website that is also related to the Internet marketing niche, but it must have a high Page Rank.

In this example, let's take Digital Point Forum (DP), it is related to Internet marketing and it has a Page Rank 6. Perfect.

All we have to do now is to copy the URL (<http://forums.digitalpoint.com/>) and head over to:

[http://check-backlink.com/cgi-bin/bl\\_checker.pl](http://check-backlink.com/cgi-bin/bl_checker.pl)

This site will reveal the backlinks of any site that you type into the 'URL' field.

So all we have to do now is paste the DP URL into this field, check all the options (Pagerank, IP, nofollow, OBL, Anchor Text) and press the 'Start Process' button).

Also make sure that you change the 'Results' from 10 to 2000.

You will now see thousands of backlinks pointing to DP, many of them being high Page Rank blog posts.

Now you can click on their URL using the firefox SEO tool to find out if they are dofollow.

Have a look at the results, page 74 is a Page Rank 3 blog and my SEO tool reveals that the links are dofollow.

All we have to do now is post a good comment linking to our page.

You can also use this method to find backlinks from image sites or forum posts and so forth.

Get your creativity on.

I hope you understand how powerful this method is. We have just used one single forum yet, and there are hundreds. This way you'll get links related to your niche, I can't stress enough how powerful those links

are.

### German Ninja Technique 3

Shoemoney.com Backlink Treasure aka how to get hundreds of back links in no time

All you have to do is visit <http://www.shoemoney.com/> (PR6) and post good comments on the articles.

You'll need 20-30 comments on one day and that's it. After 3-5 days you're going to notice that you have hundreds of back links pointing to your site.

Here is the reason why. The owner of shoemoney.com rewards people who are commenting more than others. He's adding the top 10 posters to a perm list that is on every single page of this massive High Page Rank blog.

So keep posting good comments once a week and you'll get hundreds of back links varying from PR0 to PR7. :)

Register → Click Username → Edit Profile → Create your anchor text

### The Bronze, Silver & Gold Approach

The more web sites, blogs etc. you got, the better your chances of linking. Let's say you have a decent site and a good blog, now you can get two links from the same directory you are submitting to. This way you have more leverage, furthermore you can link to yourself as well.

Please note that google shouldn't be aware of the fact that you are linking to your own sites if you don't want to lose link power. If google knows that your sites are related, your links will count less.

Therefore you shouldn't use AdSense on all of your sites. Google can see your AdSense ID and therefore they'll know who owns the site.

Try to separate your sites into 3 categories (if your sites apply for them)

Bronze → Very low quality, slightly spammy, spun articles, PLR content,

Silver → good quality content, containing secondary affiliate programs, secondary revenue streams

Gold → High quality content, supreme quality site, your main money making sites

Now this is how you can build your network of links:

Your bronze sites can link to your other bronze sites, they can also link

to your silver sites and gold sites.

Your silver sites can link to other silver sites and they can link to your gold sites as well.

Your gold sites can link to your other gold sites.

Never link downwards from your gold/silver sites to your bronze sites. Always link “up” in the ranking. Bronze to Bronze/Silver/Gold, Silver to Silver/Gold and Gold to Gold.

Building our network we want to use third party hosted sites like Blogger (Blogspot) Squidoo, Hub pages and Wordpress.org. I consider them silver sites, that's why we want to build good links to those pages. We want to use these silver sites to point/link to our gold sites, which we host ourselves.

That's how you start building a network using your own sites and sites like Squidoo.

Register → My Profile → Interests, Locations & More → Create your anchor text link using HTML in your 'About Me' box

### Podcasting

There is a free service out there by <http://www.odiogo.com/> that takes the text of your RSS feed from you blog and turns every blog post into a podcast. [www.odiogo.com](http://www.odiogo.com/) will instantly give your blog a voice, it will automatically convert your RSS feeds, text articles and post into iPod ready audio files.

People can listen to their audio files using their MP3 player or

computer.

You can install their service and then submit your podcast to lots of podcast directories, gaining massive backlinks.

There are more benefits. For every 50 competing sites in your niche, there may only be 1-2 podcasts competing. So under the condition that you have an interesting podcast, you got a big chance of ranking in the top 10 results for people searching for podcasts in your niche.

So go ahead and buy a microphone, download Audacity (free) and start recording your podcast. Then submit your podcast to all major RSS and podcast directories. Yes, you'll find a list of podcast directories in your ninja bible.

Click on Blog → Comments → Create your anchor text link at the bottom of your comment using HTML

### The recycled content backlink approach

Let me show you how to make use of your content multiple times.

First, take your articles and blog posts and convert them into iPod audio automatically with <http://www.odiogo.com/>. Submit your podcasts to all the podcast directories.

Now, mix your articles and blog posts up and create a free ebook.

Submit this ebook to all the major ebook directories, you'll find a nice list in your ninja bible. Submit these also to all the pdf directories out there. Now, use XXX to make a program out of it and submit it to all the free program directories.

Register → Submit new story → Create your link in the field 'Original News URL'

<http://i18n.counter.li.org/> (PR 6) (ninja cool)

This site tracks how many people are using linux, and where they're from.

You can sign up for your country and link to your page. Funny thing is that you can submit yourself for over 200 countries and link to your site :)

All the aged pages are PR 2-6. You can spend some time on that site and get hundreds of links. You can expect a nice PR update once Google is doing their update.

Like always, don't overdo it, make a couple of submits each day.

Free scuttle submitter script

This script will bookmark your site using scuttle script.

Press Releases

A good way to get backlinks as well as public exposure is Press Releases. It is another free way to get backlinks to your site. I'm providing you a list of sites where you can submit your press releases to, you'll find them in you ninja source.

The next ninja trick is related to press releases, let's check it out.

### [German Ninja Technique 4](#)

Google News Traffic Crusher (You gotta love this)

Wow this trick can get you some serious traffic. Not too many people

talk about this method and I'm pretty sure it's new to you. Think of Google news as of an automated newspaper.

Lots of people use Google news as their main homepage starting their day reading the news.

Making a long story short, Google news gets massive traffic and we are gonna hijack some of that traffic.

Google news picks the most popular stories out of the highly and respected news websites and they get shown on the front page.

So if we can get an article or press release on one of those respected news websites – we can watch some serious traffic coming in. Lots of people also use the search feature to find news or articles related to their niche.

Let me tell you that it's not easy at all to get into Google's resource list. And as always, Google makes it impossible to find out what criteria they use to chose who or what gets listed on Google news.

So how the hell do we get our article/press release in front of all those people?

We have to take a detour to reach our goal. Instead of trying to get listed on Google news directly (which is almost impossible for a regular Joe like me) we have to find a press release site that is listed on Google news and then we just have to publish our article/press release on that paritcular site! :)

Let me say that again. Instead of attacking Google directly, we are going to find a PR site that is in Google news resource list already! And all we are gonna publish our PR on that site so it gets picked up by Google news. How cool is that?

Let's get started

Let's head over to <http://news.google.com/> and enter your targeted

keyword in the search box.

We want to find out which Press Release sites are relevant and therefore useable. We are going to use the “Search News” button rather than the “Search the web”.

Checking the results, we need to focus on the source of the stories. Try to find the term 'Press-Release' or 'PR' in the source's name.

I entered for example 'dog training' and hit enter. No results with 'PR' on the first page. Bang, I found one on page five, first article. (as of writing this)

Now we know that <http://prmac.com/> is in the Google News resource list for the keyword 'dog training' and most likely for many more.

All we have to do now is to write or outsource high quality Press Releases or Articles and submit them to this site.

Once the Press Release is approved, we got a very good chance that it will be shown on the Google news frontpage! Lean back and watch some serious traffic pour in.

I hope you understand how powerful this cool method is.

Try to be proactive while you wait for your article's approval. Play around with other keywords and look for even more PR sites, there are lots of them.

Go get that free targeted traffic!

## Web Scripts

If you are into creating scripts which webmasters can use, then that's another chance to catch some high PR backlinks.

After creating your script, submit it to different script directories.

Clever people also add their link to the footer of the script, that way it will link to your site once the script is installed by other webmasters.

Here are two high PR script directories.

Check your Ninja Source for a big list of directories.

Look for a related blog → Make a Comment leaving your anchor text using your keyword

Register → My Zillow → Edit the 'About' section to create your links

Using this site is the easiest way to create widgets, you can then distribute and share your widgets anywhere on the web. This is another great way to build back links.

Here is what you have to do. Join widgetbox.com, then create your account. Go to my widget box and click on 'Make a widget'. Now you have to click the 'feed' button and enter your RSS feed URL. Go ahead and create your widget and publish it.

Checking your ninja source, you'll find a list with widget directories.

## The CSS Design Backlink Source

CSS galleries can be a awesome way to receive traffic and backlinks to your site. Your blog/website should have a nice look (CSS Design) though. The gallery sites can send you some serious ongoing traffic. I'm giving you a massive list of CSS sites to submit to, check your ninja source.

Register → Edit your profile and create your dofollow links

You gotta create a counter → Create your link in your profile

Register → Use the 'Homepage' section in your profile to set a dofollow link to your page

## Forum Signatures (+Ninja twist)

An old but still working method of receiving lots of quality backlinks is by getting do-follow signatures on high Page Rank forums. Some of them don't allow signatures but most of them will allow you to use your profile to set a link pointing to your site. I will provide a list of forums for you to post on, please try to make a couple of legit posts as well, don't just create profile sites. Some forums delete users for being inactive.

In order to find related forums use Google and enter the following into the Google search box:

'your keywords' + forum or

'your keywords + phpbb (or vbulletin/SMF or additional forum software names)

But why not add a small ninja twist to make some extra cash? High PR forums get quality traffic and lots of them do allow signatures. To make some extra bucks, go ahead and set up a redirect on a generic domain, redirecting the traffic to a related CPA offer.

When people interested in your signatures' topic click on it, they'll get directly redirected to a related CPA offer and you have a chance to make some extra money.

You could outsource this and have people posting for you all day, you may instruct them not to spam, but to leave senseful posts. That way you can also gain reputation and credibility.

Register → Pick a interesting post and respond using your 'About Me' Page.

Use the integrated HTML editor to create your link

<http://www.wired.com/> (PR9)

Register → Grab a interesting article → Make a comment using HTML in order to create your anchor text.

Assuming that you have a fresh (aka cool) site, go ahead and submit it to sites like 'Cool Site of the day'.

Here are the links, go ahead and submit your site.

Photo backlink heaven

Do you have nice and relevant photos on your site? If yes, go ahead and submit them to all the major photo directories. (List is in your ninja bible). Flickr.com has an Page Rank 9. Pick a couple of pictures you like and make a comment linking to your site using HTML to create an anchor text link.

<http://unasked.com/> (PR3)

This site works like yahoo answers. Every answer you give will link to your profile.

You can set your own homepage with a dofollow anchor text link in your profile.

Sign up for an account and answer 2-3 questions so that your profile page will get indexed by google – hence one more unique backlink.

<http://www.mixx.com/> (PR8)

Mixx.com is a social news aggregator and works like digg. While it's getting harder and harder to get on digg's front page you got a good chance to hit mixx's front page with a few keywords that don't have a wide audience.

This site works just like digg and is rapidly growing.

Go ahead and submit your story linking to your site.

<http://commenthunt.com/>

This service has a paid and a free version. It lists only blogs that have dofollow enabled. You can also buy blog comments which are highly targeted to your niche.

I think this site has a lot of potential.

KillerStartups

Here is a site that can provide you a boost in traffic and backlinks as well, it's called Killerstartups.com. This site is reviewing lots of startup sites on a daily basis. This is your chance to get traffic/backlinks. Just go ahead and submit your site to

## German Ninja Technique 5

The Google 'site:' Method for .edu and .gov backlinks

You can manipulate the google 'site:' feature to allow Google to find the most relevant government and university sites related to your website.

Here is what you gotta enter into the Google search box:

Site:.gov blog or site:.edu blog

or

Site:.edu inurl:blog "post a comment" or "Your Keyword" or "you must be logged in"

Google will find any .gov/.edu that has a blog or a blog directory.

Go ahead and visit those blogs to leave comments in order to get lots of .gov backlinks, try to find wordpress blogs.

Now the .edu twist.

Here is what you have to enter into the Google query:

Site:.edu \*your niche\* + blog

For example: site:.edu weight loss blog

Again, go ahead and visit those blogs to leave comments linking to your website.

You can get hundreds of free .edu/.gov backlinks this way.

You can obviously scale this method by not using the .edu .gov endings, this way the sites will have a lower pagerank. But you can get thousands of backlinks. This makes sense if you go for quantity.

Also try to be creative and use alternative queries like: 'blogs' 'blog' 'comments' 'wordpress' and so on.

The End :)
